Notice for recruitment of forty four (44) Technical Associates on purely contractual basis for FSI Cell in various State/UTs Forest Departments in all over the country

Forest Survey of India (FSI) is a premiere national organization under the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Government of India and is responsible for forest resource assessment of the country on regular basis.

Applications are invited for engagement of forty four (44) Technical Associates on purely contractual basis for FSI Cell to be set up in various State/UTs Forest Departments in all over the country initially for a period of one year subject to further extension, if required. The details such as essential qualification & experience, age limit, emoluments, place of work and selection criterion are given in **Annexure I and II**. The last date for online submission of application is 19th March, 2021.

Note: No. of posts may vary as per the requirement of the organization.

Selection Process:

Candidates who fulfill the essential/desirable qualification and experience should submit on-line application form available on FSI's website www.fsi.nic.in. After screening of the on-line application forms, the eligible candidates will be shortlisted and called for **walk-in test** comprising written test & hands on test **at the regional offices of FSI at Shimla, Nagpur, Kolkata & Bangalore and at FSI, Headquarter Dehradun**, as per the details given in **Annexure-II**. The walk-in test schedule (date & time) will be informed through email and SMS.

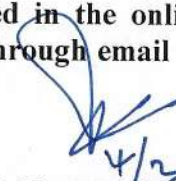
Short-listing will be done on the basis of fulfilling of prescribed qualifications, experience and age limit criteria. The final selection of the candidates will be done based on the walk-in test which will comprise two parts (i) Written (multiple –choice/Short answer type) (ii) Hands-on test on the use of Remote Sensing and GIS software (only those candidates who qualify written test will be asked to appear in Hands-on test).

The candidates may have to make suitable arrangement for stay on their own as the walk-in test may take more than one day. Candidates called for walk-in test are required to bring their mark sheets and experience certificates in original. They should also bring a filled up form on prescribed format (pdf can be downloaded from the FSI website www.fsi.nic.in) while appearing for the walk-in test. The final selection would be based on combined performance in the written test and Hands-on test. In case of any dispute in the process, the decision of the Director General, FSI will be final. **No TA/DA** will be paid for appearing for the walk-in test.

The selection and appointment of Technical Associates are purely on contractual basis and does not imply any form of permanent employment in Forest Survey of India or extension beyond the period of engagement.

Note: (i) Only one application is to be submitted by a candidate for a State/UT. If it is found at a later stage that a candidate has submitted more than one application form for one or more State/UT his candidature shall be summarily rejected.

(ii) Candidate must ensure that e-mail address and mobile number provided in the online application form as their own, as all information/communication will be sent through email on the registered email address or SMS on registered mobile number only.
